### REVISED ADMISSION POLICIES EFFECTIVE SY 2019-2020 (per BOR Resolution No. 47 series of 2018)

#### A. FIRST YEAR STUDENTS AND TRANSFEREES

##### BRIDGING PROGRAM FOR LIFELONG LEARNERS

(HS GRADUATES AND ALS PASSERS PRIOR TO 2016)

1. Applicants will be advised on the program they shall enroll taking into consideration their First, Second and Third Priority Program.
2. Lifelong Learners shall be enrolled in BLOCK SECTIONS to get the maximum number of enrollees based on the Enrollment Capacity of the program.
3. Lifelong Learners shall undergo a two-semester post admission BRIDGING Program.
4. ALS passers Certification must bear the notation that they are "ELIGIBLE TO ENROLL IN COLLEGE"

##### OFF-TRACK ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

1. OFF-TRACK SHS Graduates shall enroll in at most four (4) credit-bearing subjects taken from the SHS specialization subjects or other requisite subjects (distributed in two semesters-part of the Off-Track Enhancement Program) aligned to the course that they are applying for.
2. The subjects under the Off-Track Enhancement Program shall be enrolled as overload subjects (on top of the regular loads of the students).

\* The Bridging and Enhancement Programs are embedded in the curriculum.

\* Lifelong Learners (ALS passers and High School graduates prior to the implementation of the SHS program)

### REVISED RETENTION POLICIES EFFECTIVE SY 2019-2020 (per BOR Resolution No. 47 series of 2018)

#### B. CONTINUING STUDENTS (SECOND TO FOURTH YEAR STUDENTS)

##### RETENTION POLICY

1. ONE FAILURE in a Major subject, SECOND Failure in the same subject will mean automatic SHIFTING to another PROGRAM.
2. Students CANNOT ENROLL BACK in a program already automatically shifted.
3. A graduating student may be given CONDITIONAL RETAKE for a second failure.
4. ON PROBATION (enrolled in 15 units only) for students who fail to meet the GPA requirements for the program.

##### SHIFTING POLICY

1. SHIFTEES with more than one DRP or FAILED subjects WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED in Board Examination Programs.
2. CONDITIONAL SHIFTING to ANOTHER Board Examination Program may be allowed ONCE ONLY for students with more than one DRP or FAILED grades.
3. A CONDITIONAL SHIFTEE with DRP or FAILED grades will no longer be allowed to enroll in any Board Examination program.
4. Shifting of programs will ONLY BE ALLOWED during the first semester of every school year.
