

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
(MOA)**

WITNESSETH

Whereas, NORSU pursuant to its fourfold functions of instruction, research, extension and production shall provide assistance to support research, innovation and extension development activities that will contribute to the country's socio-economic and industrial development;

During the entire duration of the Seminar-Workshop, NORSU through:


